


Research Catalogue





At this platform events for people to participate in will be presented, the platform will be used both for communicating with the participants and to build up a possible ministry (as part of the result, see next page).




Tumblr Blog

Studio


Notebook


Tumblr has an archive function that shows all content as thumbnails; this function is genius and can help you keep your spirits up in days of confusion and feelings of low self-esteem.


Research Catalogue
