## Slow Art Day Comes to the Lamont Gallery!

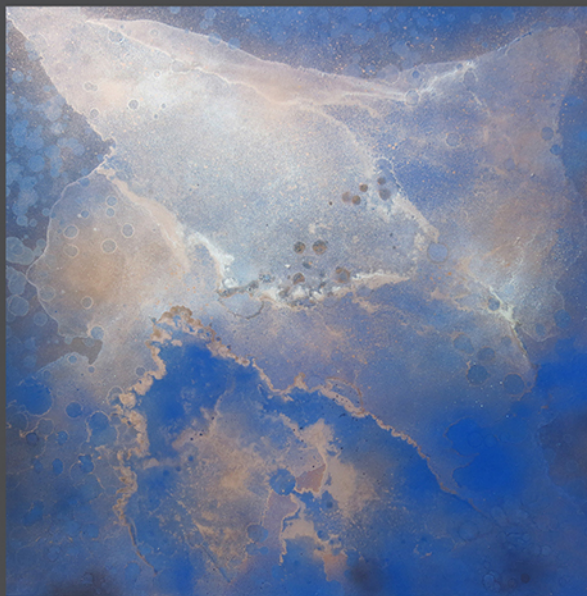
