

Dear Participants,

My name is Ines Pahaut and I am doing my third-year in the bachelor Global Studies. For my thesis, I wish to assess how does young artists in Maastricht translate their political engagement in their artwork, through the theoretical framework of Artistic Activism. Artistic Activism, for the purpose of my research, is the concept that allows activism to be communicated through artistic expression. To do so, my research consists of an audiovisual research, including interviews, photo gallery and soundscapes, which will portray five participants and their art with the aim of understanding how their identity and political engagement is manifested in their work, and how central it is to them. The interviews will last approximatively thirty minutes and include 8 questions that will be recorded in the form of a video, shot and thereafter edited and analysed by myself.

The ten questions will be the following :

- Can you introduce yourself including your name or pseudonym, nationality, age, what is your main activity in Maastricht, and any additional information you wish to share with us.
- Can you give me some informations about your artistic background? Which disciplines are you into?
- What are your motivations when creating? What stimulate your creativity and desire to produce?
- What notions of Artistic Activism do you have? Are you familiar with the concept?
- Do you consider yourself politically engaged? If yes, through which means do you think you manifest it on a daily basis?
- Do you translate your political engagement in your artwork? If yes, how central is it?
- What do you expect from your audience when you share your artwork? Do you seek to move them emotionally, to encourage them to take action, to make them understand what your position is, or something else?
- Do you think artistic activism, from your experience, has more power than other forms of activism to trigger an effect on people?
