

Open Form festival, *Liquid Vapor*, 27th of November 2009

GLASS, VAPOR AND WATER – follows the interpretation.

FORMS 2.

Popcorn 1-5 (p. 8-12 in score)

Consists of water and popcorn/membrane.

Interpretation Water I:

1. Bells (rainbow music bells www.tobar.co.uk)
 - a. Pure belling
 - b. Hand muted belling
 - c. Pouring popcorn from one bell to another
 - d. Have the bells as ears over your ears. Listen to something else in the room.
 - e. Lead the bells on the floor with popcorn inside.
 - f. Victoria will record the files to a sound bank.
2. theremin
3. diabatsji
4. data

Interpretation Water II:

1. Flexatone
 - a. With bow
 - b. With voice/singing
 - c. (With marbles)
2. theremin
3. diabatsji
4. computer

Interpretation Membrane:

1. Popping popcorn, maybe with color
2. popcorn in different containers with close up mics
3. popcorn on top of an amplifier
4. popcorn dripping in different volumes into pots and pans, or a drum. Dripping from a high distance?

ELEMENTS I: BOBLER

Interpretation Bobler I (p. 14):

Whistle tea pot boiling.

Interpretation Bobler VII (p. 19):

Folwery water: With the water that's boiled we will make nice flower teas in glass containers.

The water (dark bubbles) gets colder and colder – and the flower (light bubbles) gets nicer and nicer (Turn the graph so that it fits for this description, or play it backwards.)

INTERPRETATION OF THE TITLE WORD VAPOR

Dry ice?

Actual vapor - how?

Yngvild – chalk on glass?

Breathe on glass – soundish and visual. The face will disappear for a moment.

INSTALLATION (p. 37-40, or anything else from the score)

- Different containers borrowed from Victoria and Norsk institutt for vannforskning: filled with water. Letting marbles, peas and popcorn fall into the water.
- Kyrre (light man), Alex and Mia will make different installations.
- Bobler 5: Big water container with marbles in.
