



When you are standing at the ~~is~~ middle of the intersection, also ~~pay~~ pay attention to the road surfaces. ~~and~~ how they are

Also the side where the road continues endless, creates ~~a~~ an unwelcoming feeling.






What if there were chairs at each intersection leg of the intersection.
