However, Census Customer Services do not need to know, thank you, about a change of name for the next census as outlined in my original response:

Regarding whether there will be another census after 2021, the National Statistics has confirmed the position set out in the 2018 Census White Paper. The decision on whether there will be another census after 2021 rests with the Government and will be based on a thorough evaluation and recommendations which will be presented by the National Statistician in 2023.

Whatever the procedures will be everyone will be notified because it is an offence to supply false information or to not complete the census, and you could be fined up to £1,000. Some questions are clearly labelled as voluntary. It is not an offence if you do not answer these.

Therefore, I hope this clarifies our position from the Census perspective in

this query and no further action is required by our team.
