Sul tasto: uneven transformation

Bow Sul pont.: hold bow horizontal with both hands, move very slow longwise strings

Other info: bow pressure (crush, light) → (crush, heavy)

Cello: crush (rhythm by tone appear/disappear unevenly) use strings I - IV ad lib. *sim. (espress ad lib.)*

Dynamic: *(p)* → *(mf)* → *sim. (espress ad lib.)*

③ **c. 45 sec.** ④ **c. 20 sec.** ⑤ **c. 20 sec.**

S.t.: fast → very slow

S.p.: uneven transformation

Info: crush, slow bow, over-pressure (search for 8va basso) hold bow horizontal with both hands

bow pressure: (crush, heavy) → (crush, light)

Vc.: (crush, heavy/slowly) crush (rhythm by tone appear/disappear unevenly)

Dynamic: *f* → *8vb (mp)* → *(p)* → *n*
