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The subtitle - the second skin:

In 1999, I produced a film performance with digital video (Avid editing) in the collaboration with Berliner theatre ensemble Theater Thikwà. Theater Thikwà\* is a special Ex-West Berliner theatre ensemble consisting of performers with disability and non-disability, which had been located on Oranien Strasse in Berlin-Kreuzberg, Germany.

My project was *Drei Bewegte Figuren* with three disability performers. A girl had Autism spectrum disorder (ASD)\*\*. The communication point with her was her palm.
