Division of Labour presents 'Z is for Zero' by Gavin Wade (in association with Fred Wagemans). At Art Rotterdam Wade proposed 4 structures: Z, E, R, and O –Type Display Units (after Kiesler & Krishanitz). Using the site of the art fair as context for an experiment, Wade's 'Z-Type Display Unit' was deployed to occupy the booth as a display and support structure for works from the Zero Movement by Henk Peeters and Bernard Aubertin. The Zero Movement was a generative network built by German, French, Italian and Dutch artists between 1958 and 1966. The artworks by Peeters and Aubertin were loaned by Fred Wagemans Fine Arts, Netherlands.
