Engagement in Social Life of my Community and the Academy of Fine Arts in Prague In April 2013 I co-organized a protest event outside the Mánes building.

We demonstrated against the management of the Foundation of Czech Fine Arts (NČVU), which owns the Mánes Gallery building. (http://artycok.tv/22051/nadace-ceskeho-vytvarneho-umeni-manes)

NČVU quietly used the Mánes building as security against a bank loan to finance the reconstruction, indebting itself to the extent that it could no longer run the building as an Art exhibition space in the future. The Mánes Gallery was built as an Association of Artists by Artists. The Communist regime confiscated the Mánes building, and later in 1994 the property was privatized by a group of people who own the building until today. Before the protest event, I visited the currently active artist's associations in Czech Republic and initiated discussion on what the loss of Mánes means for artists. Afterwards, many of participated in the protest itself.

Later in May 2013, I was elected as a candidate for the democratic elections of the new members of the Shadow Board of the NČVU, and I succeeded in the election. I have been a member of this council since 2013. We made an intensive effort to contact the NČVU through several letters (http://artalk.cz/2013/06/21/tz-stinova-spravni-rada-ncvu-vyzvala-soucasne-cleny-rady-k-jednani/ http://artalk.cz/2013/07/15/otevreny-dopis-spravni-rade-nadace-ceskeho-vytvarneho-umeni/). I also discussed possible collaboration with Karel Míšek and Jiří Novotný, both members of official board of NČVU.

In 2014, together with Jesper Alvaer, we engaged NČVU, in a project funded by "Norwegian Grants". We proposed to get a 5-year grant to renew artist's association activities in one part of the Mánes building.

Subsequently (December 2014), we focused our energy to found a new Association of Artists - SKUTEK, joined by artists, art theorists, curators, and art critics. It is the only newly-founded professional organization of visual artists since 1989. I was among the founding members. I also have organized a lecture on art associations in Norway, inviting Gidsken Braadlie, one of the members of NBK.

At present, as a doctoral student of the Academy of Fine Arts in Prague, I have initiated a protest against closing down the school gallery, GAVU, together with a project on how to manage the gallery in the future. This protest was a success, resulting in negotiations with the Rector of the Academy. We represented 200 students in this matter, who supported the protest with their signatures.
