








spatial composition (a suggestion of how to treat actions and techniques in a physical space), as ensemble using no verbal communication. 1) observe and consider an empty space, 2) one participant positions themselves at a point in the space and remains stationary, 3) other participants position themselves and assume points in the space, one by one, each participant must make their choice of placement communicationless, 4) when all participants have established a position, observe with intention, 5) repeat the exercise several times to create a catalogue of spatial compositions, 6) at a not defined time, repeat compositions, if failing an attempt to repeat a composition it is considered an attempt to the next, 7) when a repetition of a previous composition is achieved, recognise it by a short finger snap applause.


