Ramstad collaborates with Olive Bieringa as the BodyCartography Project. 2018 marked the 20th anniversary of BodyCartography Project, whose work began in public spaces across the Bay Area, California, Minneapolis, Minnesota and Wellington, New Zealand. In 2018 they celebrated their 20th anniversary with the first intangible commission for the permanent collection of Te Papa Tongarewa National Museum of New Zealand and performances at the San Francisco Museum of Modern Art, Weisman Museum, Minneapolis and the Performance Arcade festival in Wellington.

BodyCartography's mission is to engage with the vital materiality of our bodies to create live performance that facilitates a reenchantment of embodiment, relationship, and presence. We create dance in urban, domestic, wild, and social landscapes. Our work is rooted in experimental dance, somatic and socially engaged practice, and public art.
