# **RESEARCH INTERESTS**

I have made a leading academic contribution to the international field of contemporary art through three inter-related collaborative projects (Confraternity of Neoflagellants; Shift/Work; Atelier), which are distinguished by a combination of academic thoroughness, methodological inventiveness, radical intermediality and expressive ingenuity.

Through these projects I have made significant contributions to Participatory Action Research Participatory Visual Methods. I have also pioneered the methods of *art writing* and *theory-fiction* and co-established the method/transdiscipline of *neomedievalism*. Additionally, I continue to produce original archival research on Visual Culture in Britain since the 1970s.

My research applies post-disciplinary, para-humanities frameworks to the production, distribution and consumption of contemporary art. It is a blend of historical, critical, materialist and fictional approaches to writing charged and torn with curatorial, paragogical and artistic work. In the pursuit of new disciplines and methods, I frequently work collaboratively, adopting shared avatars that have interpretive flexibility.

### KNOWLEDGE EXCHANGE AND IMPACT

#### Shift/Work

Since 2011, I have collaborated with Dan Brown and Edinburgh Sculpture Workshop on *Shift/Work: Developing Participatory Methods for Artistic Learning*, a knowledge exchange that investigates action-research to develop workshop models for artistic paragogy, participatory visual methods and open educational resources. We have made a significant contribution to the development and understanding of participatory artistic learning in studio and workshop settings. More widely, we have contributed post and trans-disciplinary research methods that value 'active learning' processes. We draw upon a wide range of research methods from across the arts and social sciences to document and analyse embodied, action-based and performative processes. Our research is disseminated via commissioning and facilitating workshops and symposia, critically reflecting upon the data these activities generate and presenting the outcomes in academic conferences and peer-reviewed journals. We also re-iterate the workshops at the invitation of art schools around the world, enabling participants to directly experience and reflect upon our learning processes.
