

THE MANIFESTO

WHAT IS THE FUTURE.REPAIR.MACHINE MANIFESTO?

The future repair machine manifesto is an urgent call to action of, an announcement about revaluing our socially charged artistic spirit, against a present reality. It is a response to overpowering static machines of capital, technological acceleration, ecological and environmental exhaustion.

This manifesto

- appeals to collaborative efforts, from us as artists and citizens to be an empowering voice for current and future generations
- aims to encourage the creative act of repair, to rally against today's ruins becoming monuments of excess production, overuse of finite resources and abandonement of nature
- · encourages the art of questioning.

It is far from being a text of strict direction and orders and is navigated by diverse and inclusive impulses. We recognize that within our current socio-political struggles, there is a constant need for creative communication. This incomplete manifesto invites you to fill in the blanks and to add new perspectives and questions. To playfully change, and re-shape the manifesto's statements, to replace words with actions, and expressions that lie beyond language.

This manifesto seeks to allow for a multitude of alternative opinions and proposes to form. To consider a world, although today greatly uncertain, is still open enough to let creativity sustain its future assurance.

It is the starting point for establishing the future.repair.academy, it includes the idea of the academy, a definition of a future.repair.machine done by the future generation and five statements of the consortium that founded the academy.

Finally there is a opportunity to create one's own manifesto by using the template added or by using an app (available only for android).

WHAT IS THE FUTURE.REPAIR.ACADEMY?

The future repair academy

- seeks to realise the goals above by co-creating an open-access and network-driven environment.
- wants to enable everyone who is passionate about questioning our current approaches towards repair, to re-think, re-create and to re-act within an existing dedicated network of change makers
- will ensure a safe and sustainable environment for content-based and artistically-driven discourse, practice, learning and exchange.
 Everyone who decides to join the academy will have full access to materials and data that critically reflect on current global crises, and to propose new strategies for fighting the challenges of our times.


Formats like online lectures, webinars, panel discussions, readings, keynote presentations and a theoretical body of knowledge will be shared collectively, encouraging peer feedback. By establishing this ongoing exchange apparatus, the academy hopes to kindle new collaborations, practices and initiatives. SIX ELEMENTS OF THE FUTURE.REPAIR.MACHINE MANIFESTO

These elements of the future.repair.machine manifesto are a common ground of the future.repair.academy. But they are a work in progress – that means other elements can be added, the manifesto can be discussed and changed. The manifesto elements we suggest give a direction where the future.repair academy should go.



DEFINITION OF THE FUTURE.REPAIR.MACHINE MANIFESTO BY THE FUTURE GENERATION

The machine is green. It looks like a speedy dinosaur, with hands and feet. It doesn't say anything, it just goes boom, boom, boom, Boom, a new day, boom, boom.

The machine can walk. It also has a robot inside, and a hammer. It can clean dirty air. It has tons of arms that can all do different things. It has an antenna and can call other machines on the telephone. It works all night, whenever something breaks.

The machine has wings so that it can fly and wheels so that it can drive. It wants to be close to people.

It is an under-water machine with a pipe. It collects everything that's broken. This helps the fish and the human beings.

Some sentences towards a future.repair.machine manifesto

- Repair is often misunderstood as a possibility of restoring things to some original state, ostensibly whole, perfect, healthy, functional, complete, full.
- The term fulfillment, too, promises a return to some original fullness or plenitude.
- In e-commerce, the term fulfillment also refers a special kind of retail logistics, promising the due delivery of commodities as a substitute for happiness, a service provided by so called fulfillment centers.
- In an age of overproduction, overconsumption, overflowing landfills and overabundance of greenhouse gases, we propose to do away with fulness.
- We propose to work with what is at hand, with waste, with flaws, with holes, with blanks, with glitches.
- We propose to see and enhance the beauty in what's considered incomplete, imperfect, dysfunctional, superfluous, outdated, disposable.
- We propose to see repair as a means to transform, to renew and to remake.
- We propose to see repair as a means to disrupt the smoothly running machine that creates the relentless hunger for more: more commodities, more money, more convenience, more speed, more luxury, more vehicles, more greenhouse gases, more waste, more heartache.
- We propose a repair machine that is not guided by engineerial ideals of
 efficiency and perfection, but allows people to interfere and meddle with
 it, adjust it to their own needs and desires, letting it grow, shrink and
 break down.

Repair - is the present. The present is change.

Can art really repair something? Should art really repair something?

We are not the repair machine for the society - or - are we? Could we? Should? Otherwise ...

The present is crisis. Crisis is opportunity – for change.

Change is doubt. Change is hope. Change is action.

Machine – is a past idea.

It's dangerous keeping the bad machine going.

Replacement – A tool of resistance?

uniT: IN A WORD THICKET

"The Fall marks the birth of the human word, in which the name no longer existed intact, which stepped out of the language of names, of knowing – we might even say – from out of its own immanent magic in order to emphatically, and externally, become magical. The word should communicate something (aside from itself). That is truly the Fall of the essence of language."

(W. Benjamin)

With this, the subjugation of language began: having been made a utility, its use and exploitation; and this on the basis of the knowledge of what good and evil are, of judgement. Is a redemption from the Fall conceivable? Under these conditions, what would repairing language mean?

"The word is the word of war, the communication, the utilization, the subjugation of language as a message of the spiritual nature of human beings: the subjugation is the subjugation! Speech is a part of war, the differentiation from, and the judgement of, human beings. The classification of human beings as more or less valuable, in those that speak and those that simply make sounds, in human beings and animals."

Will language as an instrument of power remain irreparable forever? What paths toward repair might be possible?

The writer as realist, who recognizes the insufficiency of what is written in the face of what is to be represented, and who cannot come to terms with this. Poetry as path? Poetry as a form of resistance against the rationality and instrumentalization of the dominant language?

Poetry as subversion and the offering up of alternative stories that subverts the language of power and offers up alternate narratives.



Poetic language as a possible way to think outside the boundaries of the normative and conventional, and to establish a deeper connection to the world.

"Dive into the words and peer into the words with a companion, peer into them listen in on them, whether they really listen to me in there and disobey, what I'm telling them?; with a companion, I want to attach myself to the words, political radicals, who fussily gnaw at the roots of a word until they, roots of air freed from their substance, dry out; hand in hand, together, we'll run after each and every syllable and sound, laugh at the periods ending sentences and deny the words of power layer by layer and, in doing so, dig the earth out from under my narration."
