Lobby & WLAN

Water

It is safe to drink tap water in Finland; according to researchers Finnish tap water is cleaner and contains less bacteria than bottled water.

Trams

Trams are the main means of public transportation in the inner city. It's easy to pay for your journey using a travel card or your mobile phone. You can load your travel card with a period of time or an amount of money and this will work out cheaper than buying a ticket for each journey.

Metro

The metro connects the centre of Helsinki and the eastern parts of the city.

Commuter Trains & Buses

Commuter trains and buses connect the centre of Helsinki with the northern and western parts of Helsinki greater metropolitan area including the neighbouring municipalities of Espoo and Vantaa.

Tickets and Fares

Mobile phone tickets are available (sms A1 to 16355) and must be purchased before entering transportation. Mobile phone tickets are valid for one hour from the time of purchase on trams, metro, the Suomenlinna ferry and commuter trains within Helsinki area. You can also purchase tickets from the driver in the buses. Day tickets can be purchased and Travel Cards charged in R-kioski kiosks.

Journey Planner

www.reittiopas.fi is a very practical way of planning your trips with public transportation. The Journey Planner includes all the buses, trams, trains and metros within Helsinki greater metropolitan area, as well as routes for walking and bicycling.

Travelling to and from the Airport

The journey by bus or by train between the airport and the city centre takes about 30-40 minutes. The local bus 615 and the local train cost about €5.50 and the Finnair bus about €6.50. The final stop of both buses and the train is the central railway station located in the centre of Helsinki.

Taxi

You can ask TeaK janitors to order a taxi or you can call the Helsinki Taxi Call Center 0100 0700.

Bicycles

To use yellow City bikes you need register for a daily, weekly or annual pass. The closest bike station is next to TeaK. More info and registration for pass: www.hsl.fi/en/citybikes. TeaK has two regular bikes and a cargo bike that can be borrowed. You have to sign a log for a key for a bicycle with the janitors.
