• Forum: We opened our "Kitchen" now. Maybe you would like to share information about where to stay in Cologne or you already would like to find a partner for a tandem? Feel free to do so there.

Where to stay in Cologne:

 On Monday and Wednesday our Lab takes place near the Station "Cologne-Ehrenfeld" at the ZAMUS (Zentrum für Alte Musik/Centre for Early Music) and on Thursday and Friday near the Main Station at the **HfMT** quite in the city of Cologne (see maps attached). On Tuesday we will be on a trip to the secondary location of the Cologne HfMT in **Wuppertal** (departure at 9 am from Cologne Main Station).

• Here are some suggestions where to stay in Cologne during the Lab. You can either stay closer to the ZAMUS or closer to the HfMT Cologne:

• Please note: The Payment for these rooms go directly to the Hotel. Visitors of Cologne have to pay a tax for promotion and advancement of culture which is 5% of the hotel-price. A stay for a work-related reasons is exempt from that tax.
