Notification - Fake Italian driver's license

I am just notifying you that I visited yesterday, 19 July 2024, Bari central police station to report in person five fake Italian passports, four of them for supposed Albanian citizens, in the fake names: "Eleni Nigianni", "Betty Nigianni" (three in total), and "Mariana Vezeteu". As I have notified you, these fake passports were used by identified Greek citizens, Dimitra Margieti, her three children, and her Greek male friend, Emmanouil Dimitrokalis, who was using the Italian passport as a female, "Mariana Vezeteu" in Haringey, London, after he was involved in an incident in Hampshire in 2018 with a fake Albanian passport.

I also reported the three fake Italian driver's licenses in the fake name "Betty Nigianni" with the number stolen from my 1994 Greek one, registered in my native Greece, used by the same under aged.

A police officer took my details and details of my British passport. Since they don't speak English, they invited a Greek woman, who works at a refugee service centre in Italy, to whom I explained in Greek the case briefly, with the Albanian immigrants abductions in Italy and the theft of their passports to make fake ones in Greece by Golden Dawn. I advised her that Georgia Meloni knows about this case and that she has paid compensation to some of the Albanian families, whose family members were abducted in Italy. She said she will report to her colleagues to search for the remaining ones.

I did make a point this is a police matter - and not an immigration one - since there are fake passports involved and abductions of immigrants.

In view of the above, please request the details of remaining fake Italian/Albanian passports from the Central Crown Courts, Camden, London, where the three under aged misidentified with those passports in September 2021. The courts have a legal obligation to provide their details.
