- There are 2,500 Greek guerrillas located in the mountains just inside 3. Bulgaria, between the Strimon and the Nestos Rivers. The exact breakdown of this group is not known.
- The Divisional Headquarters of the above troops is reported to be at Mari Rostenovo, near the Strimon River, just inside Bulgaria. This Headquarters is under the command of a Greek "General" (name unknown) who has a staff of 60 people and a radio station.
- At Newrokop a new state hospital was put at the disposal of the Greek guerrillas.* At the present time there are 60 guerrilla patients at the hospital, all reported to be casualties of the Exochi battle. They arrived at the hospital on 6 and 7 March 1949. In addition, 20 guerrillas, also casualties of the Exochi battle, have died at this hospital.
- In Katuntsi there is a platoon of 30 Greek guerrillas, while in the village of Koprilen (southeast of Newrokop) there is another platoon of 30 Greek guerrillas.
