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Name:

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1. Shape of the "body":

Define 3 integrated networks in the network. "Organs" that might correspond to the:

- a. "The head" cognition, b. "the heart" emotion, c. "the guts" drive/courage.
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2. Define 3 important "neighbours". Something the HS borders up to and interacts with.

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3. What is important for equilibrium /balance in the system.

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4. Does the hypersubject have a motivation/prerogative? (Not necessarily)

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5. What is the fundamental "emotion" / rhythm / vibe in the whole system currently? (And in the "organs") (Channel a strong emotion you have through this hypersubject)

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6. History:

- a. Age?
- b. Birth?
- c. "Parents"? (what came before / what you grew out of)
- d. General history timeline? Before (parents) and after birth.

3. A) physical maintenance B) use C) healthy institutions around D) Copenhagen works well.
4. Survival. No radical city planning.
5. HS emotion/vibe: (quiet, introvert, waiting) Organs: (trees - resting, hibernating) (people: freezing, introvert, some play)  
(structures: cold, stable, happy)
6. History:
  - Age: 122 years old.
  - Birth: 1898. Born out of old iron foundery demolition. Trees planted same year.
  - Before/parents:
    - 1700s - prins Carls barokke landsted, Blaagaarden (given name)
    - 1790 - landets første seminarium, Blaagaards Seminarium.
    - lazaret, treater, nedbrændte i 1833.
    - 1834 - isenkræmmer Heegaard jernstøberi
    - 1852 - small industry, people, storage buildings, workshops
    - 1910 Plasa designed by arkitekt Ivar Bentsen and sculptor billedhugger Kai Nielsen.
