
Cross-pollination Form

This form is a tool to explore a chosen material in multiple and unforeseen ways.

Start by filling in words into the three categories. The words can be random – selected from a book, video, a conversation or other material – or chosen by a particular interest or topic.

Category I	WHAT 5 things, places or times (e.g., winter)			
Category II	DOING 5 actions or movements (e.g., drift)			
Category III	WHERE / HOW 5 placing in time or place, or describing using 1–3 words (e.g., all afternoon)			

Now, use the words from each category to fill in the next form ready to cross-pollinate. Note that category II should be filled out twice – once in each of the two sections below.



For each of the words in category I, you will now have 25 cross-pollinated variations representing different sensory information. Explore each cross-pollination through moving, drawing, and/or writing.
