To read the manifesto

- Print the next two pages in a single A4 sheet (double sided). If you need to change sides manually in your printer, make sure to rotate the paper as needed.
- Hold the paper looking at the side with a dashed line. You should be able to read the word <u>method</u> right side up. Fold across the dashed line, bringing the top part to the bottom.
- 3. Fold again in half, bringing the left part to the right.
- With a pair of scissors cut off 3 mm across the top edges, in order to be able to turn the pages.

Then, get very, very quiet and let your onw voice speak through you.
