Christer Windeløv-Lidzélius is an internationally recognised expert in the fields of leadership, strategy, innovation, and entrepreneurship. For 25 years, he has been working as a leader, entrepreneur, and a consultant. Christer has given keynotes, lectures, and advice on 5 continents in around 40 countries for private companies, NGOs, and public organizations like the European Commission alike.

Christer was the principal at Kaospilot for 17 years, a frontrunner in the educational landscape, recognized by UNESCO, Fast Company, Monocle, BusinessWeek in terms of its innovative educational design for fostering leadership and entrepreneurship. He stepped down in Q1, 2024. Main results are: Kaospilot as an international brand and operation, a financially solidified operation, gone from one education to a house of educations, and having 10.000+ through their professional programs.

After stepping down he has focused on advisory roles, board memberships, own projects and academic responsibilities (see below).

Advisory roles consist of strategy, business development, internationalisation, leadership and innovation question for organisations stretching from Oman to Brazil and Japan to Denmark.

Christer is a professor at Elisava School of Design and Technology in Spain in Business Design and Strategy, as well as a visiting professor at Saint Paul Business School in Sao Paolo, and an associate professor at Stockholm University of the Arts in Entrepreneurship & Leadership.

He pursues three projects, Lumina, rrarre and Spiro. Lumina is a technology company in Denmark aimed at detecting substances in fluids. rrarre is an investment company in Stockholm bringing ideas, entrepreneurs, and capital together. Spiro is a school focusing on integrative business and design out of Barcelona and Madrid.

Christer has extensive board experience and contributes to a variety of fields. For instance, he was part of The Forum d'Avignon in France under the ministry of culture, a think-tank
