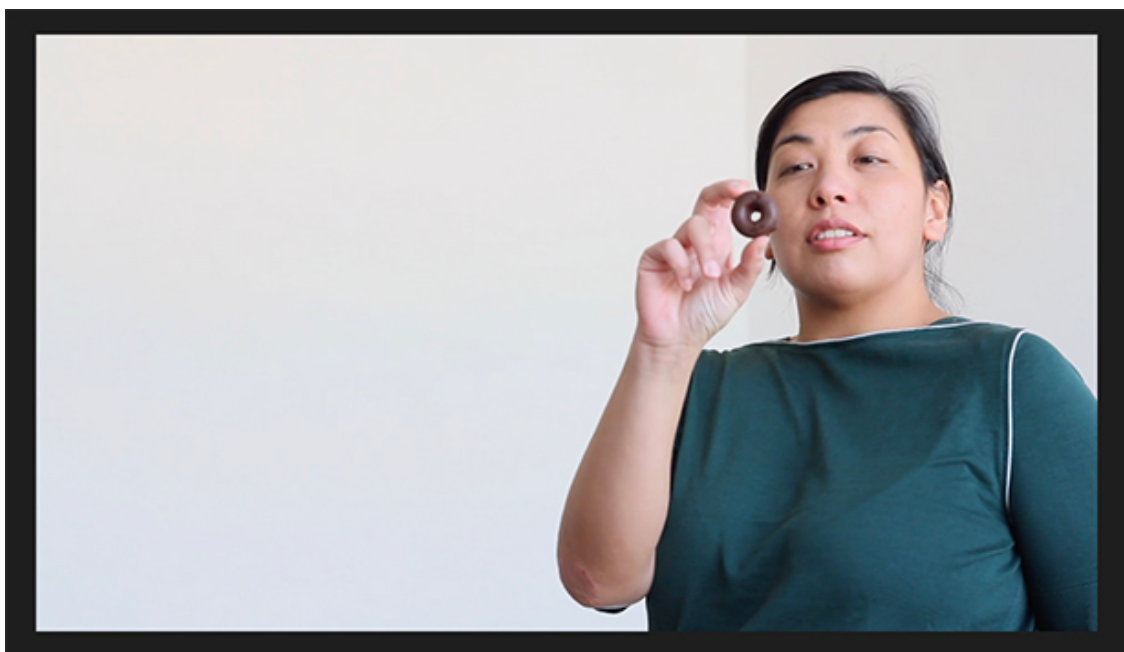


Artist Panel: Moving Together

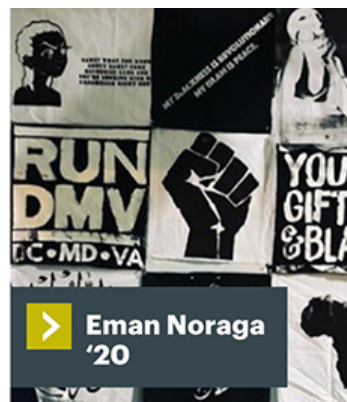

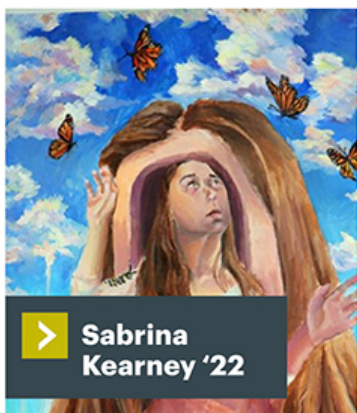

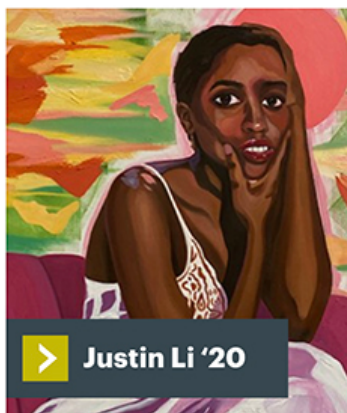
