My IDP will center around coming up with practical solutions for tackling otherness that comes from living or experiencing inventing imaginary worlds differently from other human beings based on how I want to create a handbook, easily understood by my peers as well as beginners taking their first steps towards story-playfulness on a stage.

I will do this through labbs, co-labbs or interviews - present results through instructional videos, text, web-page etc.

Inventing grounded empirical ways to test my hypothesis about brain functionality differences on stage, camera, audience. rehearsal room, at work, at home.

Possible topics taking off from:

- Line reading
- Showing your true nature behind a constructed normal facade
- Differences in keeping an active here-ness in different levelled playful actions at hand
- No-box-thinking contra inside-box-thinking during/before/inventing/etc performativity
- Rejection sensitivity from directional criticism contra uplifting positive direction through playfulness
- Word processing disorder levels taking direction or executing text tasks
- Audio processing disorder " -

- Authorian leadership with ODD, PDA — Self-based motives for action, training, directives. Contra non-submissive levelled leadership

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Documentation through easily understandable performable actions via text, video or internet-based communal communication platforms
