Evalutation: SoundShapes

The experiment showed that the two dimensions we provided to the participants, despite different subjective descriptions with the adjectives, nevertheless showed a similar sensation regarding the noise music scale.

So the identification of the boundary between noise and music seems to meet with more agreement than the description of it. In particular, the experiment shows how differentiated sound is perceived and processed and thus how difficult it is to draw conclusions from subjective descriptions to concrete sounds.

Improvements and possible continuations would be:

- 1. more careful selection of terms
- 2. not revealing the task before the assessment in order to get an unbiased result.
- 3. adding more participants in order to have a clearer data set
- 4. choose a quieter environment for the experiment to ensure appropriate concentration of the participants
- 5. possibly explore whether a personal acquaintance leads to a more similar result on average.
