








Saint brothers Naum & Kliment Ohridski Technique: poster – design acrylic colour Dimension:30cm x 20cm




Part of the body of work from Kurbinovo exhibition inspired by the monastery in Makedonia Technique: Oil on plywood | Dimension: 80cm x 80cm





"Since there is no single set of abilities running through human nature, There is no single curriculum which all should undergo. Rather, the Scholl should teach everything that anyone is interested in learning."
