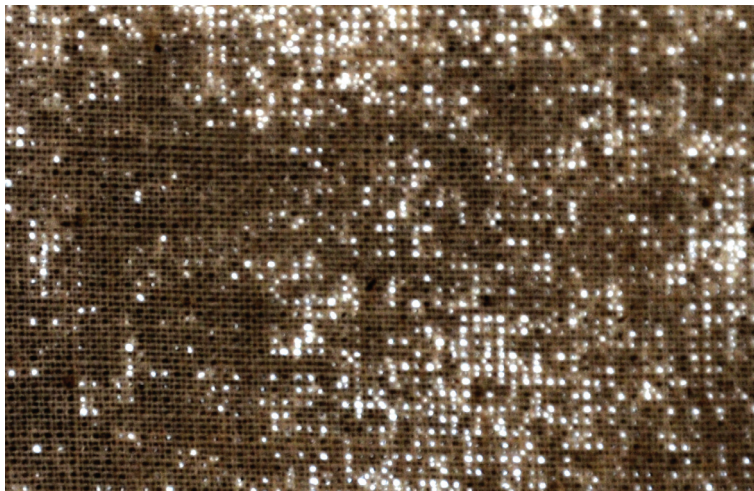


Fine airborne
dry mist

Particulate densities
separate and diffuse through
fragments of illumination,
catching shadows

In the subtle eddies of air, the particles bend and fold
gravity is no longer visible
only sharpening aggregates of dirt-soaked light.

Powder
eases
into variable



paces of settle.
excess falls through the grid openings,
leaving delicately patterned powder piles.

On one side the dirt is contained by the smooth hardness of a glass plate
a cross-sectional cut of pure visibility.

A layer of loose topographical grit spliced by a perfectly hard shine,
revealing the underside of its crevices.
