I actively pursue the strategy of synchronising research and pedagogy. Most of my teaching is either based on or carried out in collaboration with the international and interdisciplinary research projects I have led in The Centre for Practice as Research in Theatre T7, a research centre for The Faculty of Communication Sciences.

### Teaching philosophy

As a direct result of my research activities, my pedagogical approach to and philosophy within the areas of the Performing Arts, Digital Media/Arts and Creative Technologies are to produce and foster knowledge of the historical and current changes in agency, subjectivity and social cohesion that affect the embodied, societal and ecological forms of knowledge and creativity, which develop under different political and cultural circumstances.

The *implementation and assessment* of the above approach in teaching includes the study and analysis of potential, existing and historical spaces, texts, embodied interactions and artistic/cultural production processes, which not only reflect the prevailing politics of a certain era, but pass their ideological premises on to future practices by modes of a) **intermediality** (stratifying techniques and methods that resensibilisate or 'refresh' perception) and b) ways of **identification** specific to each cultural practice (individual agencies in relation to specific cultural conditions).
