But there's something about knowing the year clearly and making social associations to it. Giving the audience another perspective and a way of reading.


J: if you weren't born you could ask go to someone and take from them (like in characters)

We're going to go back W.A.L.T. - thinking through something -  
- finding score - writing - looping — called year/age



If a year is called out: everybody drop what you're doing. If you weren't born you can chose: step out, continue with what you had, take from someone else.

After looping → writing → Reflective.

Guign disposes the space with scattered chairs around the room. He also puts a quite small pile of costumes in a corner, a bag of costumes by one of the two pillars, and a pair of feathered wings by the fuse box. All this is set out during the first round of writing.
