

Do This Mian VI. Newcastle
fasten clamps ("C" claps, woodworking, etc. of various sizes)

over playing area on each of the four strings. flip clamps with fingers in such a manner that they rebound between adjacent strings.

maybe off VII.

place small objects of metal (paper clips, hair pins, etc.) on each string in various positions above bridge. perform double-stops, arco and/or pizzicato.

VIII.

holding bass by fingerboard upside-down, balance on scroll.

1. rub object of rubber (suede-leather brush, etc.) over strings *Comb*
2. rub, crumbling to small pieces, large piece of cellofex over strings
3. roll narrow wheeled furniture caster slowly down from endpin over tailpiece, bridge, G string and into pegbox (caster may squeak)

IX.

Rigoletto; I bar. Acc. 1000 winds

holding bass right-side-up perform long tones and double stops with two bows (right and left hand) *pizzicato*

Accord Andante mosso *Tremolo*

Bird or sax
