In the large space, I've set up a round table with 64 facedown cards. Guests are welcome to join the activity. Throughout the exhibition, I'll be seated at the table, signaling the start of new storytelling sessions. It's not possible to join ongoing stories, and once you've chosen to participate in a story, you can't leave.

We begin with "Once upon a time," and I draw one of the cards to start a story inspired by the image. Participants take turns drawing cards, continuing the narrative based on the card they've chosen. The whole experience concludes when the last person around the table finishes their part of the story with a simple "the end."






Kaja Engseth Dahlen
