Writing Letters to Trees with the Trees

This presentation is related to the strand in the sense of being an "experimental form of writing in artistic research", with the aim to subtly "disrupt and displace conventions" and "queer scholarly writing", related to "interests in fictioning and speculative fabulation". The practice of writing letters to trees by the trees, a form of semi-automatic writing addressed to the tree with the camera as witness, has been developed as part of the project Meetings with Remarkable and Unremarkable Trees and explored with various trees in Finnish, Swedish and English.

In scholarly terms it can be placed within the emerging field of critical plant studies, art's return to vegetal life, performance studies and artistic research.

Rethinking our relationship to other forms of life that we share this planet with is a central task for artists today. Artistic research can contribute through its capacity to allow and to generate hybrid forms of thinking and acting. This project wants to contribute to this growing field with examples of relatively simple artistic practices, writing letters to trees next to trees being one of them. This presentation proposes the perhaps controversial idea that a thought occurring to the writer while writing next to the tree might be provided by the tree, as their contribution to the conversation. This idea can be understood as a literary gesture or dismissed as pure fantasy, but it could also be seen as a possible solution to the dilemma of communicating with trees. Patricia Vieira proposes "the notion of inscription as a possible bridge over the abyss separating humans from the plant world [because] all beings inscribe themselves in their environment and in the existence in those who surround them." (Vieira 2017, 217) Following this line of thought, although we could expect the human who writes to the tree to be doing the inscription, we could also see the trees inscribing themselves onto the text, which emerges in the encounter.



II DEVELOPING THE PRACTICE - EXAMPLES

Writing notes between sessions spent with trees

Sunday with a Pine (8 min 12 sec) performed on 24. September 2017 every two-hours between 8 AM and 8 PM in Nida on the Curonian Spit

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Writing next to trees (or shrubs), addressing them at some point

Day with a Juniper 1 & 2 (21 min 56 sec) performed on 3. August 2019 every hour between 7 AM and 9 PM on Utö, Finland Writing a letter to the tree (afterwards)

Year of the Dog in Lill-Jan's Wood (Sitting in a Pine) performed 100 times between 14.1.2018. and 3.2.2019 in Lill-Jansskogen Park, Stockholm
