## Keynote presentation by Thomas Crombez |

Craftmanship & Technology |

Creative assistants and artistic risk-taking: Reflections on craftsmanship,

industrialisation and Large Language Models

Artists and designers are today invited to welcome a whole new generation of "creative assistants" into their studios. From automatic image generation to creative writing and sound design, new creative tools promise that "Al" will revolutionise their artistic practice.

In this talk, lecturer Thomas Crombez will examine artistic working methods, and the role that creative assistants (both the very old and the very new) may fulfil. Does the promise of "Al" – i.e., to bridge the divide between the predictability of industrial processes and the creative freedom of craftsmanship – make sense? Is there too much risk involved, or maybe even not enough risk?



Thomas Crombez (1978) is a lecturer, philosopher, author and publisher. He is associated with the History of Graphic Design at the Royal Academy of Fine Arts (Antwerp / Belgium) and Fontys Academy of the Arts (Tilburg / The Netherlands). He is also lecturer in Philosophy of Art and History of Graphic Design at Sint Lucas College of Art (Antwerp).

He studied philosophy and theatre studies at the universities of Brussels and Antwerp.
