



Airida Gudaitė is a professional dancer, choreographer and teacher with more than 30 years of dancing and 17 years of educational experience. One of the most active female choreographers in Lithuania, co-creator and artistic director of the innovative Urban Dance Theatre Low Air which examines social issues in its works. The company brings unique dance forms

and synthesis of movement and raw physical language into the contemporary dance landscape. Choreographer Airida Gudaite aims to reimagine the artistic power of urban dance and by crossing the borders make an impact to the spectator.

Choreographer's works with the company is constantly touring the world and is programmed for festivals like Tanzmesse Germany, Cannes Dance Festival France, SIDance Korea, WESTWIND festival Germany, One Dance Week Bulgaria, Suzane Dellal Israel and many more. The choreographer takes great courage presenting a dance piece for the YOUNG audience, a performance that serves as a meeting point to explore personal space of young in power relation towards adults. The performance awarded with the highest Lithuanian Theatre Award as the best theatre production for the young audience of 2021. Airida Gudaite co-established the company Low Air in 2012 as the first expanded urban dance theatre in Lithuania. The company's debut piece "Feel-Link" was the first urban/hip-hop dance production in Lithuania and on its debut was nominated for the Lithuanian Golden Stage Cross theatre awards (Best Debut of the Year). The choreographer Airida Gudaite the following year was awarded as Best Choreographers of the year for their second dance piece "Home Trip" (Best Choreography of the Year, 2013). The next 2 dance works by choreographers were nominated for the Golden Stage Cross theatre award. Visual dance piece "Game Over" was awarded as the Best dance piece of the year 2016. Same year Airida Gudaite and her creative partner Laurynas Zakevicius were awarded Borisas Dauguvietis Earring for both the successful research and development of new stage forms connecting urban dance and theatre and for the pedagogical work which changes the face of Lithuanian contemporary dance. Furthermore, choreographer of Low Air was awarded by the Lithuanian contemporary dance association. In 2017 Ministry of Culture of the Republic of Lithuania awarded Low Air choreographer and dancers Airida Gudaite with a National award given to young creators. Since 2017 Low Air company is titled with Vilnius city dance theatre. Airida Gudaite holds the position of Artistic director of the company since 2012.
