

As the mastermind behind *Project Viola Ten*, he's passed every test that scientists have thrown at him. Is he telepathic? Or just a damn good cheat?

RI: Do you mind if I call you Dr. Telepathy?

Eddie Dean: I'd rather you didn't. I'm not quite finished with my PhD at the University College Cork. But yes, psycho-physical telepathy is the subject of my research.

What is psycho-physical telepathy?

It's my approach to telepathy. It begins with an assumption that the mind is created by, and inseparable from, the body.



How does it feel to be the world's most in-demand mind reader?

Wow. Gosh. I don't really see myself that way. I see myself more as a motivational speaker, fitness guru, communications consultant, personal development coach, supermodel, celebrity Z-lister, and rock star.

Are you psychic?

I'm beyond psychic.



Beyond psychic?

Psychic is an old word based on outdated science and a misunderstanding of the mind and body. I'm way beyond all of that.

But you are telepathic?

Telepathic is also an old word. But I am telepathic in the sense that I do what was once thought of as telepathy. I call it non-visual/non-auditory communication.

Are there downsides to being a telepathic rock star?

Being a rock star is a dirty business. If it was easy, everyone would do it. The same for telepathy. It's not something I choose to be. It's just something that I am.

Can anybody do what you do?

Yes...No...Wait...Yes and no.

Care to elaborate on that?

Everyone has innate perceptive and intuitive capacities. So everyone can experience intuitive or telepathic-like insights. But I possess an unusually singular focus toward developing these capacities. That focus gives me an uncommon edge.

Is it true that you were in the circus?

I worked as a trapeze artist when I was younger. And *Project Viola Ten* began as part of a residency at the School of Acrobatics and New Circus Arts in Seattle.



I heard that you destroyed a laboratory during Project Viola Ten.

Yes. I may have gone a bit Shakespearean that day. But those people were tearing me apart. I'm not an animal. I'm a human being.

What would your dream job be?

I enjoy being a telepathy rock star. Most days, it doesn't even feel like a job.

Do you want the whole world to believe in telepathy?

I'd be happier if the whole world believed in themselves.

What do you mean by that?

People are confused. And my research gets to the truth: Communication is everything. Pay attention to other people and pay attention to yourself. Your body is your mind, so eat vegetables, read books, get exercise, drink smoothies.

What is the most important lesson you've learned from studying telepathy?

Nobody succeeds alone.

Ingredients:


A pear A banana

A squeeze of lime


Blend and enjoy. It may not make you telepathic, but it sure can't hurt!



EXTENDED-SENSORY PERCEPTION


Many—if not all—people have ESP ability, if they are tested under the right conditions.


Approximately 10% of the population is thought to be "highly sensitive." How do you score?

These shapes—circle, cross, waves, square, and star—were selected for use in Extra-Sensory

Perception tests by JB Rhine and Karl Zener at the Parapsychology Laboratory of Duke University.

This test is for two players. One player is the sender; the other is the receiver. In a quiet place, sitting back to back, the sender mixes the cards thoroughly. When both are ready, the sender says "Now," randomly selects a card, and concentrates on that shape.







Corner

The receiver should call the shape which is visualized most clearly. The receiver may make only one call per card. Both the card and the call are recorded in ink by the sender.

Without letting the receiver see the card, it is placed face down on the table and the process is repeated with the next card. Do not talk during the test, avoid unnecessary noises, and never indicate whether a call is right or wrong until the end of the run.

The hits are then checked and the total score written at the bottom of the sheet. This process should be repeated five times, for a total of twenty-five tests.








