
CHRISTINA JAUFRNIK

From 2015 - 2017 she held a position as artistic researcher in the team of the interdisciplinary research project INTRA SPACE led by Wolfgang Tschapeller who is supervisor of her doctoral thesis at the Institute of Art and Architecture, Academy of Fine Arts Vienna. Her interest lies in spatial and artistic practices negotiating the potential relations of (non)human/more-than-human figures, and space as uncertain, diaphanous states of sensory engagement, perception of self and (engineered) others. Her research approach cultivates performative and media based spatial practices stemming from her background in both architecture and contemporary dance. She is interested in complicating, corrupting and expanding established methodologies and perspectives, experimenting with moving bodies, apparatuses, texts, objects, and projections in spatial settings. Since 2012 she has been working with the architectural team of Wolfgang Tschapeller ZT GmbH Vienna. Among her main involvements have been the exhibition and publication for the Austrian Pavilion at the Architectue Biennale in Venice in 2012, a Fine Arts Library at Cornell University, Ithaca New York, and recently an exhibition at ORIS House of Architecture in Zagreb. Christina collaborates with architects, artists and scientists of different disciplines, developing works for public space, theatre and galleries, such as SommerSzene Salzburg, Festival for Fashion and Photography Vienna, Kunstraum Niederösterreich, brut Wien.
