TEACHERS	How do you perceive/think about the program?	Do you see any changes in your students' (name) behaviour or learning processes in the last months, that you could connect to the coaching sessions? What?	
Teacher 1	They know that someone drops by. Focusses their practicing. Broader context – they are part of a practice program.	Hard to say. Very young students. We always did lesson notes.	
Teacher 2	I like that the ones who really uses LLAB so much progress: E.g. One of them uses the map, uses the notes. If the student can bring LLab into her system it's great. But older ones tend to use it less. I think it would be great for everyone!	Three of the students really benefitted – it was necessary for them. How to study. Using moments before school. More prepared for lessons, more proactive, more reflective.	
Teacher 3	Some didn't go (the older ones) to the group sessions. Had a hard time linking the themes with the topics. They would like to have someone there when they are practicing. I thought they would get more out of it. It's a fantastic subject.	One student struggles with attention. Not enough improvement.	
Teacher 4	Love that it's there. I don't have enough time with the students. I answer Anna's questions about improvements. My student doesn't bring her map/notebook. We have our own team – also together with Irma.	I like that one of the students is working with fantasy & images, colours – musicality. She needs more organisation.	
Teacher 5	It is really great that they have a coach, apart from the teacher, who is not connected to their main subject teacher. It is an extraordinary chance.	Yes – she felt more at ease. When she needed help it was there, so she needed less help. Op haar gemack. Grew in confidence	
Teacher 6	From what I know I'm in favour. I would like to know more. Overview from Anna. Didn't know about the teacher training/ meetings. Can't do morning sessions. Would like to be part of it somehow. Would like a copy of the workbook material.	Hard to tell why. Improvements in practicing: on top of the full program of what it is that she's practicing. Beneficial.	
Teacher 7	Idea is great. Demands more time from students – challenging. Students can be more aware of how to train themselves, more independent.
