Søren Kjærgaard is a Copenhagen-based pianist, composer, improviser, educator and artistic researcher who encompasses a variety of settings. His work has led to various international exchanges, performances, lectures, commissions and a growing discography of critically acclaimed albums.

Søren Kjærgaard has performed across Europe, US, Canada, Brazil, China, South Korea and Japan both solo and with various artists, and since 2015, he has been working as associate professors at the Rhythmic Music Conservatory, currently also holding positions as vice principal and head of research and development.

In his artistic research, Kjærgaard investigates the trans/interference of sonic identity through sampling and code, practices of critical and diffractive listening and ways of disseminating knowledges in performative formats.
