Categorizing sound

- Descriptions of sound related to the following senses:
 - Hearing (Ear)
 - Tactility (Body)
 - Vision (Eye)
 - Smell (Nose)
 - Taste (Mouth)

Descriptions of sound related to the ear

- Loud – Quiet (dynamics)
- Low – High (spectrality)
- Frontal, from above, from the side, from below, distant, close (spatiality)
- Descending, ascending, rapid, slow, stationary, constant (movement/time)
- Short – Long (standstill/time)

Descriptions of sound related to the body

- Warm, cold, hard, soft, wet, dry, pointy, sharp, round, coarse, fine, massive, light, heavy, elastic (material)

Descriptions of sound related to the eye

- Blurry, transparent, clear, unclear, sharp, focused, edgy, metallic, smooth, rough, thick, thin, unfolded, folded, broken, ramified (material)

Descriptions of sound related to the nose

- Spicy, perfumed

Descriptions of sound related to the mouth

- Sweet, sharp, sour

Descriptions of sound loaded with a heavier reference

- Windy, dripping, thundering, rocking, growling, hacking, rattling, (experience)
- Dreamy, lovely, awful, intense, annoying, random, wonderful, insisting (judgement)
